Not all launches resulted in rescues. In some cases they 'stood by' for many hours.

1910

FEB 10 inside breakwater in Bay.

Schooner KATE of Weymouth. Crew assembled no service

Aug 21 Fishguard Bay

Unknown

Crew assembled no service

Oct 13 Ramsey Sound

Assisted St. Davids' lifeboat after capsize and loss of crewmembers, whilst rescuing crew from the Ketch DEMOCRAT . Helped save 10 men and one vessel. [See separate write up.](#)

1911

Jan 12 Fishguard Bay SS Dynamo of Hull (saved 14) & Schooner Lizzie Edith of Truro (saved 4)

Ditto ditto Schooner Agnes Craig of Chester . Landed 5

Ketch Democrat of Barnstable . Landed 3

Hopper 'The Fishguard'. Landed 2

Feb 11 Dinas Head Ketch 'Mouse' of Cardigan. Assisted to save 1

Feb 22 Smalls Ship 'Celtic' of Liverpool. Crew assembled, stood by.

Dec 22 Fishguard Bay , back of breakwater. Ketches 'Wolf 'of Bideford & 'Arthur' of Bridgwater, stood by.

1912

Feb 7 off Dinas head SS City of Cambridge of Glasgow,, stood by.

April 9 Fishguard Harbour. A rowing boat

Oct 21 Ditto, close to Saddle Point. Dredger 'Porteur' of London. Saved 2

1915

Jan 22 Back of Eastern Breakwater Schooner 'Hetty' of Falmouth . saved 4 and one dog.

Nov 12 Ditto 3 masted SS Emlyn of Cardiff. Saved 6

Nov 13 1 ½ miles W of Strumble Head. Barque 'Calbuga' of Nova Scotia, stood by

1917

Feb 20 4 to 5 miles SW of Strumble head. SS 'Leysian' saved 37 in three round trips through the night lasting over 15 hours.

May 21 500 yards W of Outer Rock of North Bishop. SS 'Colonian' of Liverpool, stood by.

1918

Oct 16. 5 miles N of Abereiddy. An Airship. No service but chased the airship for 5 hours.

1920

Nov 16 Adrift 5m W of the Smalls, Brought up to Aberyswyth. Ex Cruiser 'Amethyst'. Stood by all night.

Dec 3 Fishguard Bay, Needle Rock. 3 masted schooner Hermina of Rotterdam . Saved 7. [See separate account of this famous rescue.](#)

1922

April 17 18m NE of Fishguard. Schooner 'Lusitania 1' Stood by through the night. (NB not THE Lusitania)

1927

Dec 25 Between Eastern Breakwater and Castle Point. Schooner 'Kate' of Barrow. Saved 3

1928

Nov 25 ¾ m E of north breakwater lighthouse. 2 masted tramp steamer 'Chislehurst' of London. Stood by.
1929

Nov 5 8m NW of Strumble Head. Dredger 'Branker' of Liverpool. Stood by

Nov 28 Greenore Point (co.Wexford) SS Goleta of Swansea, gave wrong position owing to fog. No service.

23/4/1930 Final launch to search for missing lad. Treated as exercise which was overdue.
